I must always wear my hat in the playground to keep me safe from the sun.



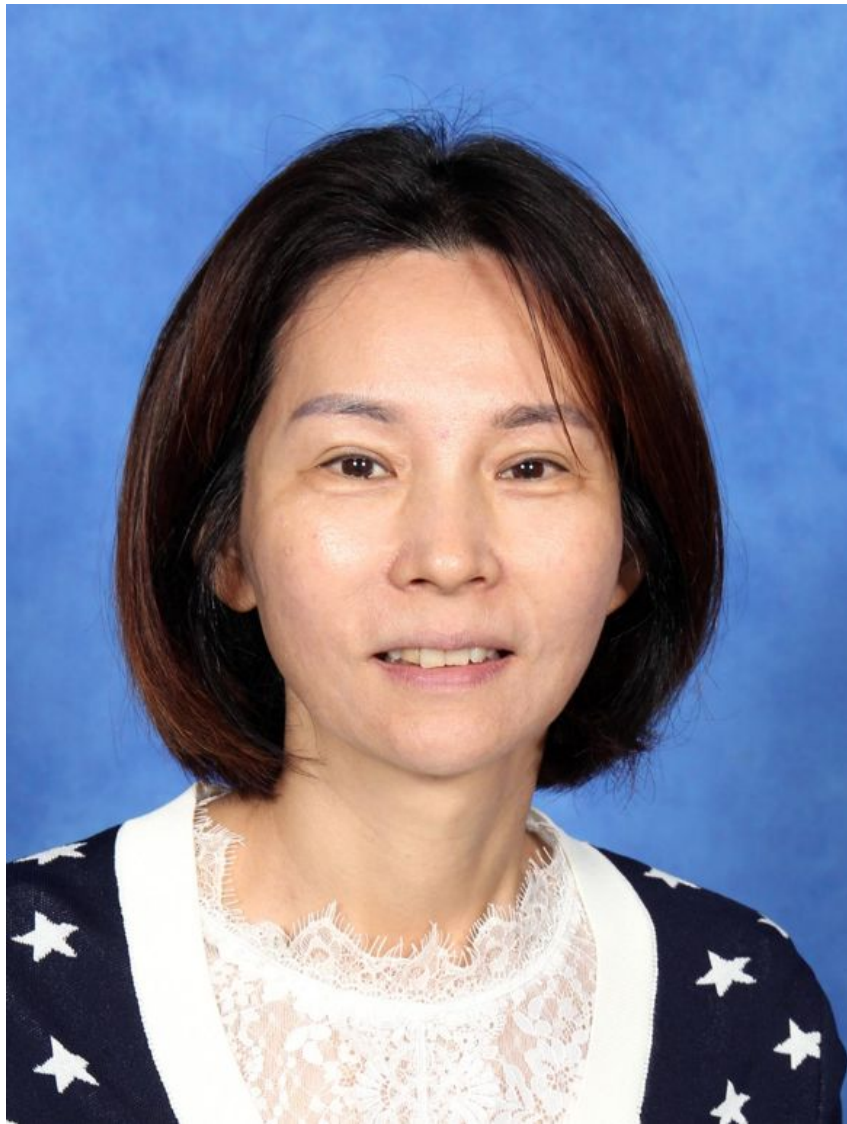
This is the Principal of my school.

There are lots of different places in my school. Here are some of them:

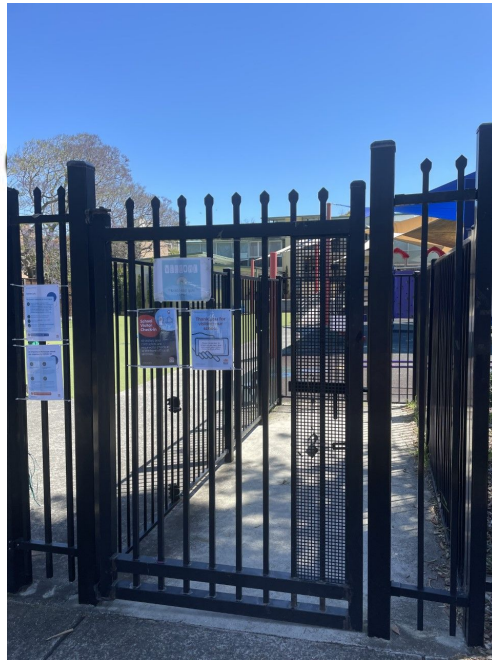

Some of the bells mean that it is time to have a break and eat some food. This is when I can eat my sandwiches, fruit or other food that my parents have put in my lunch box.

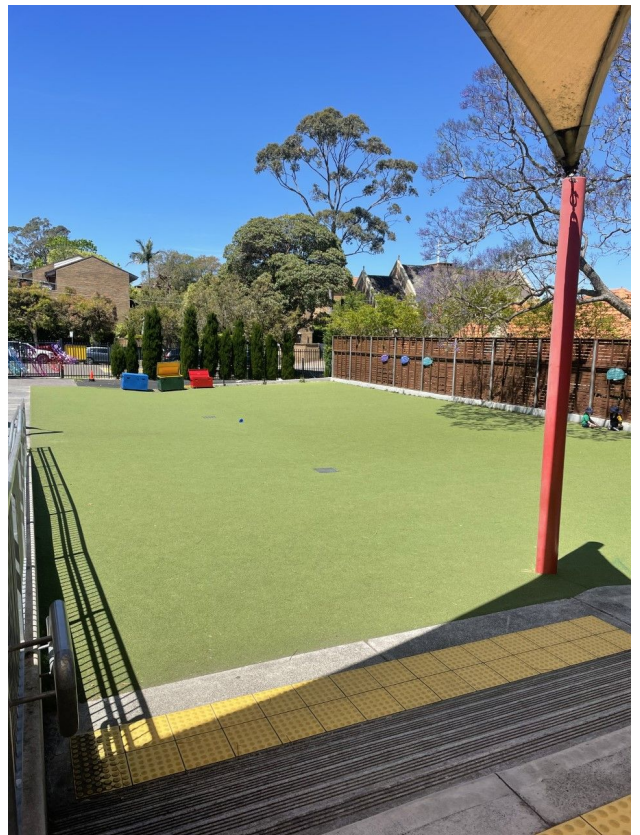


I will take my food out of my bag and sit with the other students in my class to eat my food.

playground!





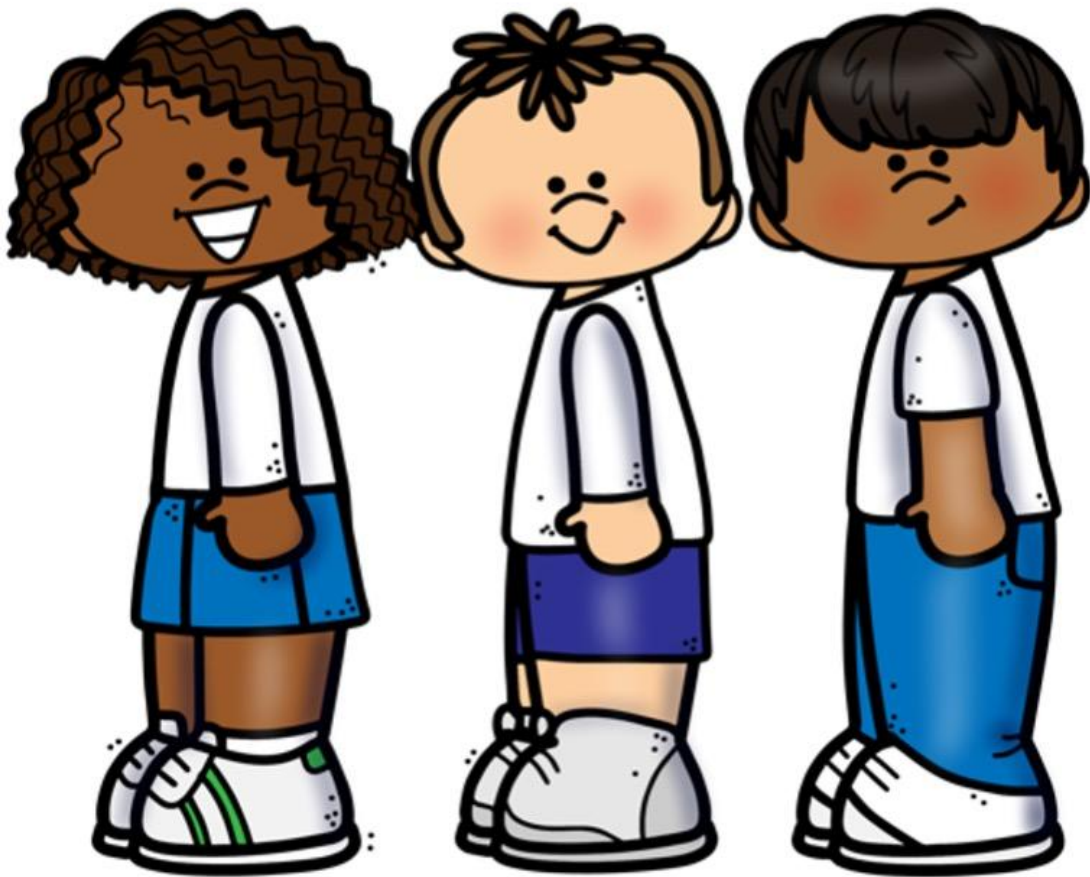
There are always teachers in the playground to help me if I get hurt.

I will need to share and take turns.

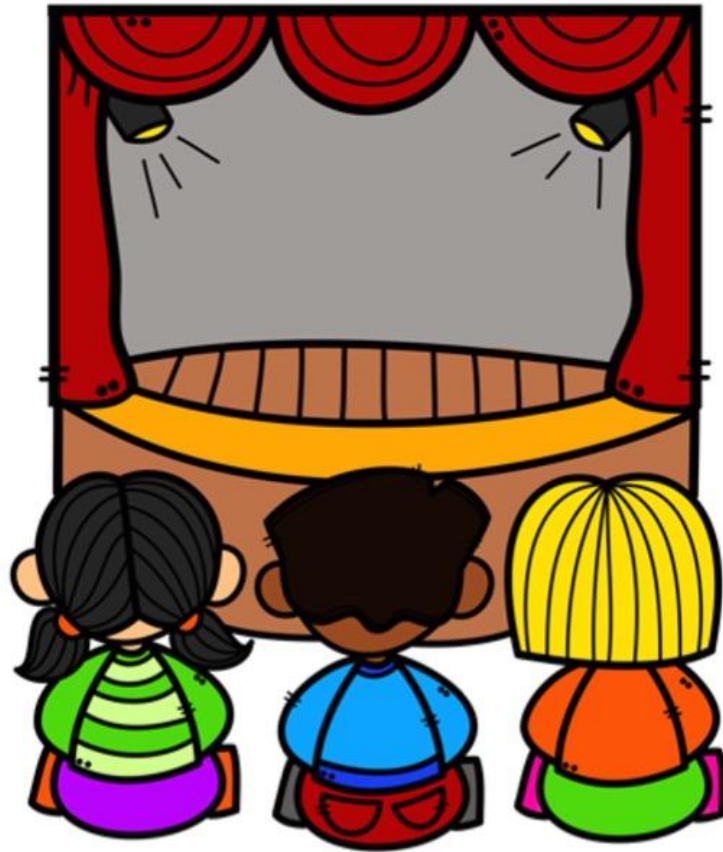


When I sit on the floor, I will sit with my
